DEALER SERVICE EQUIPMENT AIR POLLUTION CONTROL MODELS:

ALL MODELS

We are just entering a period of great changes in State and Federal regulations covering air pollution control and surveillance outdating the original type of exhaust gas analyzer.

In order to ensure that owners' vehicles conform to Federal and State regulations, it will be considered a mandatory requirement that all British Leyland dealers be suitably equipped to read carbon monoxide and hydrocarbon levels. Quite apart from the regulatory aspect, this type of engine analysis is a valuable diagnostic and service promotional piece of equipment.

At the present time, only the non-dispersive infra-red type of gas analyzer has the ability to meet these requirements. It is suggested that dealers plan to have this equipment or its equivalent by the end of 1973. The cost of these units ranges from \$1,695.00 to \$2,350.00.

Presently, British Leyland has national programs available, with Sun and Marquette, which allow dealers to purchase through their British Leyland Distributor analytical equipment at a reduced price. Distributors have all details of this program.
