Re. Charging Circuit Systems

1968 and Subsequent Models

It is vitally important all dealer personnel are aware of the change in the 1968 charging system and terminal grounds.

MODEL	SYSTEM	GROUND
MGB and MGB/GT	ALTERNATOR	NEGATIVE
SPRITE/MIDGET	GENERATOR	NEGATIVE
AUSTIN AMERICA	GENERATOR	POSITIVE

If the batteries are EVEN MOMENTARILY hooked up in reverse on an alternator system, the rectification diodes will burn up and a new alternator will have to be fitted.

PRECAUTIONS

- (a) Disconnect the ground lead when rapid charging batteries.
- (b) Disconnect the battery ground terminal when carrying out any electric welding on vehicle
