Re: Recommended Lubricants

All Models

There appears to be a certain amount of confusion in the field over the desirability of using detergent or non-detergent, single or multi-viscosity types of engine oil in B.M.C. engines.

Assuming the engine oil is of an M. S. (Motor Severe) specification, detergent or non-detergent, single or multi-viscosity types, are recommended, providing it is only of a premium quality and a change is not made from a non-detergent to a detergent type.

It is left to the discretion of yourselves, what viscosity is recommended, based upon the climatic conditions and type of driving the vehicle undergoes.
