TO ALL DISTRIBUTORS AND DEALERS

Re: Maintenance Of Wet Charged Batteries On New Vehicles

It is of the utmost importance that batteries in storage, or on new vehicles on the dealer's premises be examined and given a freshening charge every three weeks to a month.

Remove the battery from the vehicle, store in a cool area top up with distilled water and recharge at the rate of two - four AMPS for six hours every three weeks to a month.

Ensure the tops are kept clean and dry to prevent surface discharge and corrosion.

It must be remembered, Lucas Electrical Services will not accept Warranty Claims on batteries that have sulphated, where this could have been prevented by following the procedure above.
